

Applying Scripture Everyday

Pray On Your Spiritual Armor: “Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might. Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore, take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to resist on the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm. Stand firm therefore, having belted your waist with truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having strapped on your feet the preparation of the gospel of peace; in addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. And take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. With every prayer and request, pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be alert with all perseverance and every request for all the saints...” **Ephesians 6:10-18**

Hide It In Your Heart: “I have treasured Your word in my heart, So that I may not sin against You.” **Psalms 119:11**

As A Guide For Living: “Your word is a lamp to my feet And a light to my path.” **Psalms 119:105**

Read & Examine It: “Now these people were more noble-minded than those in Thessalonica, for they received the word with great eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see whether these things were so.” **Acts 17:11**

Meditate On It: But his delight is in the Law of the LORD, And on His Law he meditates day and night.” **Psalms 1:2**

Encourage Others With It: “Let no unwholesome word come out of your mouth, but if *there is* any good word for edification according to the need of *the moment*, say *that*, so that it will give grace to those who hear.” **Ephesians 4:29**

Evangelize With It: “...for “EVERYONE WHO CALLS ON THE NAME OF THE LORD WILL BE SAVED.” How then are they to call on Him in whom they have not believed? How are they to believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how are they to hear without a preacher? But how are they to preach unless they are sent? Just as it is written: “HOW BEAUTIFUL ARE THE FEET OF THOSE WHO BRING GOOD NEWS OF GOOD THINGS!” However, they did not all heed the good news; for Isaiah says, “LORD, WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR REPORT?” So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.” **Romans 10:13-17**
